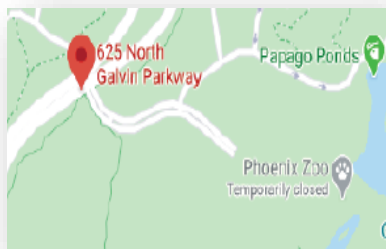

### Papago Park

**625 N Galvin Pkwy, Phoenix AZ 85008**

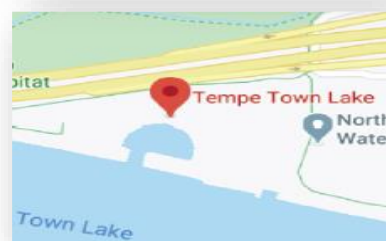
The trails that interlace the area are generally easy treks. The smooth footing and low elevation gain make it a popular place for running and mountain biking. Papago Park is home two of Phoenix's favorite attractions, the Phoenix Zoo and the Desert Botanical Garden. Papago Park also has an archery range and orienteering course!.



### Arizona State Capitol

**1700 W Washington St, Phoenix, AZ 85007**

Located in downtown Phoenix, the Arizona State Capitol displays several architectural styles. The dome and column reflect classical stylings of ancient Greece and Rome. The materials for the building are largely indigenous to the region, including locally-sourced copper and granite. With Wesley Bolin Plaza Park located adjacent to the Capitol it's a perfect location to visit.



### Tempe Town Lake

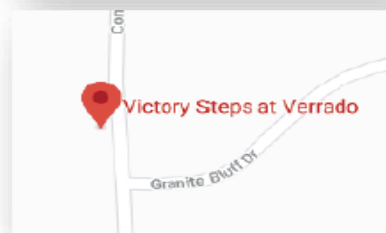
Located on the NW corner of Mill and Rio Salado Parkway is home to the two-mile-long manmade lake where you can rent a boat, attend stand-up paddleboard yoga and or go for a walk or run along the 5-mile path surrounding the lake.



### McCormick-Stillman Railroad Park

**7301 E Indian Bend Rd, Scottsdale, AZ 85250**

The 30-acre park, located in the heart of Scottsdale, Arizona, is the most unique park of its kind in the country. It features a 15 in gauge railroad, a Magma Arizona Railroad locomotive, a railroad museum, three model railroad clubs and a 7 1/2 in gauge live steam railroad.



### Victory Steps at Verrado

**N Verrado Way, Buckeye AZ 85396**

There are 340 steps up and 340 steps down! Victory Stairs is a 0.2 mile out and back again trail that is a favorite with Arizonan's. It offers so many scenic views and is good for all skill levels.
