

# PUT THE FUN IN FUNDRAISING

Fundraising should be just that — FUN! Follow these steps to help your fundraiser be successful:

#### STEP 1:

Start a fundraiser. Which type of fundraiser speaks to you? Do you have a milestone around the corner, or do you want to hold an event? Maybe you want to show appreciation to a CHOC care team or want to give meaning to a 5K. Pick something fun that you'll enjoy — after all, this is FUNdraising!

#### STEP 2:

Donate to your page. Donating to your own fundraiser shows that you are not only asking for support, but that you are giving support too. You're committed, and you show it.

#### STEP 3:

Share on social media. Spread the word to your network to extend your reach. People love to help make a positive impact and sharing your story will bring awareness and help make your cause stand out.

#### STEP 4:

Email family, friends and colleagues. Reach out to your inner circle. Don't be afraid to ask. Family, friends and colleagues want to support you. Tell your story, share impact, and send news and updates.

#### STEP 5:

Thank and send updates. Let your supporters know they're appreciated. Send a personal thank you message to each of your donors or give them a shout-out on social media. Acknowledge that they are making a difference.

# FOLLOW THE FUN

Most people share cause-related posts on social media, and they love to help make a positive impact. Here are some quick steps to get you on your way:

#### STEP 1:

Share your message. Tell your story to help engage your audience and make your cause stand out.

#### STEP 2:

Be short and sweet. Use numbers, quotes and fun facts that your friends and family can share with their network.

#### STEP 3:

Mix it up. Don't just share "ask" posts — share updates, news about CHOC and other information like photos and videos to bring your campaign to life.

#### STEP 4:

Give thanks. Show your appreciation by tagging people who have already given and thank them for their generosity.

#### STEP 5:

Add #CHOCRaiseUp to all your social media posts to be part of our larger CHOC fundraising community.

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Have a question? We're here for you. Below you'll find answers to the most frequently asked questions about fundraising for CHOC.

#### IS THERE A MINIMUM FUNDRAISING REQUIREMENT?

No. There is no minimum requirement to fundraise for CHOC Foundation. Set any fundraising goal that you are comfortable with, whether it's \$100 or \$100,000. Every campaign makes a difference!

#### DO I GET TO CHOOSE WHERE MY FUNDS GO?

Yes! When you start a fundraiser, you will have the option of choosing where you want your funds to go.

#### ARE DONATIONS TAX-DEDUCTIBLE?

All monetary donations are tax-deductible to the extent allowed by law.

#### WHO SHOULD I MAKE MY CHECK OUT TO?

Please make all checks payable to: CHOC Foundation

Please make sure to state "CHOC Raise Up" and the fundraiser's name in the memo line.

For example, please write "CHOC Raise Up - Jane Smith."

#### WHAT CAN I DO IF A CHECK IS WRITTEN OUT TO ME PERSONALLY?

If a donation check has been written out to you personally, you may endorse the back of the check and mail it to the CHOC Foundation. Please make sure to state "CHOC Raise Up" and the fundraiser's name in the memo line. For example, please write "CHOC Raise Up - Jane Smith."

#### WHERE SHOULD I MAIL DONATION CHECKS?

#### WHAT IS A TAX ID NUMBER AND HOW CAN I FIND IT?

A tax ID number identifies the CHOC Foundation as a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. Many donors will request this number to validate their donation as tax-deductible. The CHOC Foundation tax ID number is 95-6097416.

### WILL YOU SEND A REPRESENTATIVE TO MY EVENT AND / OR PROVIDE VOLUNTEERS?

Due to limited resources, we cannot commit CHOC Foundation staff or volunteers to events.

#### CAN I MAIL IN A CASH DONATION?

We recommend against using mail to send cash donations. Instead, you may drop off the cash at the CHOC Foundation along with your information, or you can deposit the cash into your checking account and send a personal check from your account.
