

The inpatient Celebration Area houses our End of Treatment Bell and represents one of the most special milestones in a cancer journey: the last inpatient stay or last chemotherapy treatment.

With the average inpatient stay being 5-7 days, the Aflac Cancer Center becomes a home-away-from-home for many our families. A brain tumor diagnosis is the most common form of solid tumors, and our volumes make us one of the largest pediatric brain cancer programs in the country.

BREAKING DOWN THE NUMBERS

- 64 inpatient beds at the Aflac Cancer and Blood Disorders Center
- 167 new brain or spinal cord cancer diagnosis in 2019 alone
- 68 new families diagnosed with a brain or spinal cord cancer as of June 2020
- 100+ families are currently in treatment for a brain tumor at the Aflac Cancer Center
