**APPLICATION GUIDELINES**



**HERE FOR YOU**

**T**he Merrill Oncology Center Travel Fund was established in 2020 using funds raised through the Scott Hamilton CARES Foundation as a result of a Sk8 to Eliminate Cancer™ event held in Lake Placid. Eligible cancer patients will be able to access funds to assist with travel expenses related to their treatment. Applications will be evaluated and approved by a committee appointed by the Adirondack Health Foundation. Patients with a household income of \$60,000 or less are eligible to complete an application. Patients can be reimbursed for up to \$1,000 a year, and grants are made on an equal opportunity basis regardless of race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity or national origin.

**Check that the following apply to you before submitting your application:**

- Applicants must have their primary residence in the greater Tri-Lakes region.
- Travel expenses are limited to the patient and one travel companion.
- The fund does not reimburse healthcare expenses, medical equipment or medications.
- Expenses for gas mileage (based on IRS mileage for medical care rate), train fare, flights, lodging recommended by the receiving hospital, food, ferry tickets, parking or tolls will be reimbursed up to the annual maximum of \$1,000.
- The fund will provide up to \$25/day for food per person; it does not cover alcohol.
- No expense will be reimbursed unless it is accompanied by a receipt.
