What We Do

Every summer for the past 46 years, 200+ fundraisers will meet a challenge to raise awareness and money to support **Anchor House**, a safe haven in Trenton, NJ for abused, runaway and homeless youth and young adults.

Our Challenges

Our 46th annual **Classic Ride** is a 500-mile bike ride over 7 consecutive days July 13 - 20 on roads through the countryside. It starts in Harrisonburg, VA and ends in Trenton, NJ. (About 71 miles/day)

Our 5th annual **Flex Ride** is a 500-mile bike ride over 6 weeks June 8 – July 20 on a route of the rider's choice. (About 83 miles/week)

Our 5th annual **Flex Walk/Run** is 100 miles over 6 weeks June 8 – July 20 on a route of the walker's choice. (About 16 miles/week)

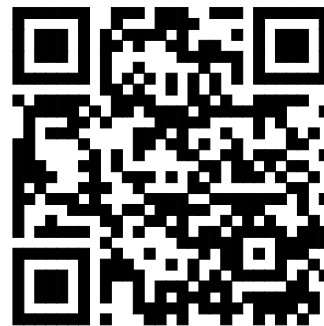
Anchor House services are offered to young people ages 12-24. These services include:
