- When my sister was just 10 years old, she woke to unbearable head pain. After rushing her to our local hospital, physicians told us to wait three days for observation. Luckily, a pediatric critical care specialist, Dr. Knight, was on call at that hospital and suggested she be transported to CHOC. Her scans revealed an arteriovenous malformation (AVM), a tangle of weakened blood vessels that ruptured and started a brain bleed. Upon arrival to CHOC, Mackenzie immediately underwent neurosurgery. She was placed in a medically-induced coma for several days, and we didn't know if she would survive. Thankfully Mackenzie recovered after spending months with child life specialists, physical therapy, and rehabilitation learning how to walk and talk again.
- 3 Not long after her surgery, we attended our first CHOC Walk. We were moved to see how many community members come together to support CHOC and their mission: to Nurture, Advance and Protect the Health and Well-Being of Children.
