WHY THIS TASK WAS IMPOSSIBLE

During the Holocaust, the Nazis built and operated over 42,000 camps, including satellite camps under the major camps. While the work the Jews had to do while imprisoned may have been different, the type of work was the same. The Jews were required to do back-breaking manual labor under horrible conditions - limited food, crowded bunks, and no access to basic healthcare.

The point of this matching task was to illustrate how the experience in each camp was just as horrible as the last. You shouldn't have been able to tell what happened where since no matter where the Jews were sent, they had to suffer through inhumane circumstances.
